od tells us in 1 Corinthians to examine ourselves before communing. We encourage hose communing to ask themselves:

- Do I believe that I am a sinner?
- Do I believe that Jesus Christ is our only Savior from sin, death and Satan?
- Do I believe that Christ is present in this Sacrament, even if I do not understand how, with His very Body and Blood, given and shed for my sins, as the Word of God declares?
- Do I have a desire to live the kind of life God asks me to live, but recognize that I cannot do that apart from the power of the Holy Spirit, who works in this meal to embolden and strengthen my faith?
- If this is your confession, you are welcome to commune here. Hold your hand out to receive the host (wafer). Children not instructed or those of a different confession may come forward with their arms crossed to receive a blessing.




