

The Celebration of the Lord's Supper

God tells us in 1 Corinthians to examine ourselves before communing. We encourage those communing to ask themselves:

- Do I believe that I am a sinner?
- Do I believe that Jesus Christ is our only Savior from sin, death and Satan?
- Do I believe that Christ is present in this Sacrament, even if I do not understand how, with His very Body and Blood, given and shed for my sins, as the Word of God declares?
- Do I have a desire to live the kind of life God asks me to live, but recognize that I cannot do that apart from the power of the Holy Spirit, who works in this meal to embolden and strengthen my faith?

If this is your confession, you are welcome to commune here. Hold your hand out to receive the host (wafer). Children not instructed or those of a different confession may come forward with their arms crossed to receive a blessing.

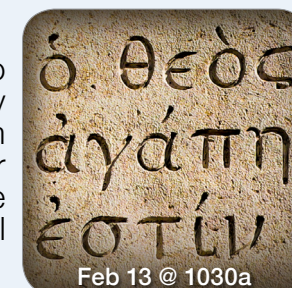
ONE WORSHIP & MINISTRY FAIR

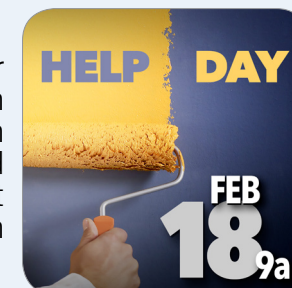
AGAPE BIBLE STUDY
