
od tells us in 1 Corinthians to examine ourselves before communing. We encourage those ommuning to ask themselves

If this is your confession, you are welcome to commune here. Hold your hand out to receive the host (wafer). Children not instructed or those of a different confession may come forward with their arms crossed to receive a blessing.
